24 Nov	Day 1: Transfer from AC/EC venue to a hotel in Thimphu <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move from AC/EC venue to a hotel in Thimphu • Evening stroll in Thimphu town, explore the Handicrafts Market, enjoy dinner of your own choices 	(-/-)	3-star hotel in Thimphu
25 Nov	Day 2: Highlights of Thimphu <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visit Buddha Dordenma – a massive 51-meter bronze statue overlooking Thimphu Valley; drive takes around 20 minutes from city center. • Visit National Memorial Chorten – a sacred site where locals gather for daily prayers and circumambulation; located about 10 minutes from Buddha Point. • Explore the Textile Museum – discover Bhutan's rich textile arts and traditional weaving techniques; around 5–7 minutes by car from the Chorten. • Stop at the Bhutan Post Office – create your own personalized stamps, a fun and meaningful souvenir; just a short 5-minute drive away. 26 Nov	Day 3: Scenic Drive to Punakha & Cultural Exploration <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drive to Dochula Pass – enjoy panoramic Himalayan views (weather permitting) and visit the 108 Druk Wangyal Chortens; the pass sits at 3,100 meters and is about 1.5 hours from Thimphu. • Visit Chimi Lhakhang (Temple of Fertility) – a short walk through rice fields leads to this revered temple dedicated to the “Divine Madman,” known for blessing couples seeking children. • Explore Punakha Dzong – one of Bhutan's most majestic fortresses, located at the confluence of two rivers; rich in history and architectural beauty. • Visit Sopsokha Ecological Village – a model eco-village promoting traditional lifestyles, local crafts, and environmental harmony. • Walk across the Suspension Bridge – one of the longest in Bhutan, offering stunning river views and a peaceful moment in nature. 27 Nov	Day 4: Gangtey Morning & Paro's Cultural Gems <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Morning visit to Gangtey Gonpa in the Phobjikha Valley – a revered Nyingma monastery set on a hilltop overlooking the broad, glacial valley; known for its peaceful ambiance and as the winter home of the black-necked cranes. • Take a short nature walk in Phobjikha Valley to soak in the serene beauty and local village life. • Drive back to Paro with lunch en route. • Visit the National Museum of Bhutan – housed in a former watchtower above Paro Dzong, showcasing the country's cultural, artistic, and natural heritage. 	(B/L/D)	3-star hotel in Paro
28 Nov	Day 5: Hike to the Iconic Tiger's Nest <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hike to Paro Taktsang (Tiger's Nest Monastery) – Bhutan's most revered site, perched dramatically on a cliff at 3,120 meters. • The round-trip hike takes approximately 6–8 hours, with a steady uphill climb through pine forest and prayer-flag-lined paths. • Stop at the mid-way café for tea and scenic views of the monastery. • Explore the monastery complex and soak in its spiritual atmosphere.
