



April's Special: Ladakh Spring Blossoms in the Himalayas 15-22 April 2026

A rare window in the high Himalayas—when Ladakh begins to awaken from winter. Apricot blossoms soften the stark mountain landscape, monasteries hum quietly with prayer, and the air carries both stillness and renewal. This journey invites you to experience Ladakh not only as a destination, but as a living landscape of culture, spirituality, and inner reflection.

DATE	DETAIL	FOOD
D1: 15 Apr 2026	Bangkok - Delhi - Leh Your journey begins with an international flight from Bangkok via Delhi to Leh, the capital of Ladakh. As you ascend into the Himalayas, the vastness of the landscape unfolds beneath you—snow peaks, deep valleys, and high-altitude deserts.	
D2: 16 Apr 2026	Arrival in Leh - Gentle Acclimatization Upon arrival in Leh (3,500m), you'll be transferred to your hotel. Today is intentionally slow—allowing your body to adjust to the altitude. Rest, sip warm tea, and take in the crisp mountain air. In the late afternoon, a short, gentle walk introduces you to Leh's peaceful atmosphere—whitewashed stupas, prayer flags, and distant monastery chants. D3: 17 Apr 2026	Leh - Nubra Valley via Khardung La Journey across one of the world's highest motorable passes, Khardung La , into the magical Nubra Valley. The landscape shifts dramatically—wide sand dunes framed by snow-capped peaks. Visit Diskit Monastery and its towering Maitreya Buddha statue overlooking the valley. In the evening, settle into your lodge and enjoy a quiet Himalayan night. Stay: Walnut Inn Hotel https://thewalnutinnresort.com/	(B/-/D)
D4: 18 Apr 2026	Nubra Valley - Pangong Lake Travel deeper into remote Ladakh toward the breathtaking Pangong Lake , known for its ever-changing shades of blue. Arriving by afternoon, you'll witness the lake shimmering under vast open skies. This is a place of silence and contemplation—where nature speaks in stillness. D5: 19 Apr 2026	Pangong Lake - Return to Leh Wake early to experience sunrise over Pangong—an unforgettable moment of light and reflection. After breakfast, journey back to Leh, passing through rugged mountain terrain and traditional Ladakhi villages. Evening at leisure. - D6: 20 Apr 2026 **Sacred Monasteries of Ladakh** (B/-/-)
A day dedicated to Ladakh's spiritual heritage:
 - **Thiksey Monastery** – a majestic hilltop monastery resembling the Potala Palace
 - **Shey Palace** – former royal residence with a giant Buddha statue
 - **Hemis Monastery** – the largest and wealthiest monastery in LadakhThis day offers insight into Tibetan Buddhist traditions, ritual life, and the deep connection between landscape and spirituality.

Booking & Cancellation Terms

Booking & Payment

- A non-refundable deposit of **15,000 THB per person** is required to secure your seat.
- The remaining balance must be paid **no later than 30 days before departure**.
- Bookings made within 30 days of departure require **full payment upon confirmation**.
- Confirmation is subject to availability and receipt of payment.

Cancellation Policy

- Deposit is **non-refundable** under all circumstances.
- Cancellation **more than 30 days before departure**: refund of balance payment (excluding deposit).
- Cancellation **15–30 days before departure**: 50% of total program fee will be charged.
- Cancellation **less than 15 days before departure**: 100% of total program fee will be charged.

IMPORTANT NOTES BEFORE TRAVELING TO LEH, LADAKH (NORTHERN INDIA)

1. Meals are mostly local vegetarian (VEG) Indian or Chinese style and may be repetitive (e.g. fried rice, stir-fried noodles, various soups and curries, naan, roti, Indian rice, fried or grilled chicken).
2. Roadside meals will often be at small local restaurants outside the city, which may lack urban-level comfort and take time to prepare.
3. Some meals may be delayed due to unpredictable circumstances such as traffic, landslides, vehicle breakdowns, etc.
4. Toilets during travel may sometimes mean using nature (behind rocks or bushes). Guests are kindly requested to not leave toilet paper in nature and instead dispose of it properly back at the hotel.
5. On some days, the itinerary may require early departures, with breakfast and lunch served as boxed meals for convenience and to save travel time.
6. Itinerary changes may occur based on road conditions, traffic congestion, or military vehicle convoys commonly seen in Leh-Ladakh.
7. Some hotels may not have elevators or heaters, and power outages may happen occasionally due to reliance on generators.
8. Please refrain from bringing pork products, as Leh is home to diverse communities including Muslims, Hindus, and Buddhists.
9. Altitude sickness is a risk due to high elevation. If you have pre-existing health conditions, please consult your doctor or visit a travel medicine clinic. Diamox may be taken and adjusted based on symptoms in Leh. Side effects may include dry mouth and frequent urination.
